INCLEMENT WEATHER REMINDERS -- All weather or other emergency cancellations of weekend Masses will be announced on WFMZ. Daily Mass is cancelled whenever Southern Lehigh School District announces either a delay or cancellation for winter weather.

BLESSED CHRISTMAS WAFERS or "Oplatki" are available in the vestibule of the church. There are four wafers per pack at \$2.00 per pack. An instructional pamphlet is enclosed with each pack of Christmas Wafers explaining this centuries old Christmas tradition. The entire family, at Christmas Eve or Christmas Day dinner, traditionally shares the Christmas Wafers after the blessing, prior to eating the meal. Each family member may offer a prayer for the family while breaking off a piece of the Christmas Wafer, then passes the wafer to the next family member. This would be a nice family custom to begin, or continue, by adding another spiritual dimension to your holiday celebrations.

THE JESSE TREE located in front of the steps to the altar. is an Advent tradition named after Jesse, the father of King David. Biblical symbols representing the ancestry of Jesus, either in faith or in bloodline, are added one by one to the tree starting December 1st and ending on December 24th. Feel free to take a look! December 8th – Passover (Doorway With Lamb's Blood) December 9th - The Ten Commandments (Tablet With 10 Numbers)

December 10th – Ruth & Boaz (Sheaf Of Wheat)

December 11th – David & Goliath (Slingshot)

December 12th - Prophecy: A Shoot From The Stump Of Jesse (Stump & Leaf)

December 13th - Prophecy: The New Creation (Lion & Lamb Together)

December 14th - Prophecy: Prince Of Peace (Dove & Crown)




