

A second collection envelope dated November 22-23, mailed to all parishioners, is for St. Joseph's St. Vincent **de Paul Society.** The donations provide the following to our community: rental assistance for people who are facing homelessness, help with car repair bills to keep people working, assistance with paying utility bills, food assistance due to food insecurity at to the current loss of SNAP benefits, and other individual needs. Our Society members make a home visit to those in need giving them other resources available, such as Betty Lou's Pantry, PA COMPASS, Family Promise, Catholic Charities, and other options for shelter if necessary. The members of our St. Vicent de Paul Society has seen an increase this October of calls from people in need. This charitable organization is primarily funded through the second collection. The money placed in Poor Box, located in the church entrance is for year long giving. Please recommend our services to those you see in need. One of our members will contact the person as soon as possible. 
